- Proficient in full-stack development, working on both the web application (Typescript/React/Redux/Styled Components) and the API (Elixir/Phoenix).
- Developed and maintained the design system and component library resulting in notable improvements in design consistency and a significant reduction in development time.
- Built and optimized a distributed billing system using Elixir, ClickHouse, Kafka, and Kubernetes, integrating Stripe for payment processing with custom plans.
- Built the Vercel Marketplace integration for Mux, enabling users to sign up and provision resources directly from Vercel using OIDC for authentication.
- Introduced Typescript to the web application resulting in fewer bugs and clearer code, implemented mobile-optimized development, accessibility enhancements, and testing best practices.
- Led a team of engineers in a major brand redesign project, transforming the visual identity of the entire web application.
- Championed growth team initiatives, prioritizing user onboarding and achieving successful conversions to paid users.
- Mentored and supported a returning worker through a returnship program, helping them successfully reintegrate into the workforce and grow as a professional.
